

## New interactive literacy resource

A new interactive **Topic Taster** has recently launched called **My Community**. This can be found in the 7–11 year-old section of the Teachers' area of the Box Tops for Books website. This activity focuses on PSE/PSHE and Citizenship and adds to the wide range of **Topic Tasters** covering Science, Geography, History and Art.

**Topic Tasters** are free activities designed for interactive whiteboards which give pupils a flavour of the topic they're studying as well as developing their literacy skills. All are curriculum-relevant and can be used either as an introduction to a topic or as a revision activity to reinforce what's already been covered.

## My Community **NEW! FOR 2010**

Pupils are asked to consider what a community means to them and how they'd like to improve their own area. They then create a poster describing what improvements they would like to make to their local area.

There is a **downloadable activity sheet** for teachers to give to their pupils as an extension to the main online resource as well as supporting **teachers' notes** with curriculum links and helpful tips on delivery.

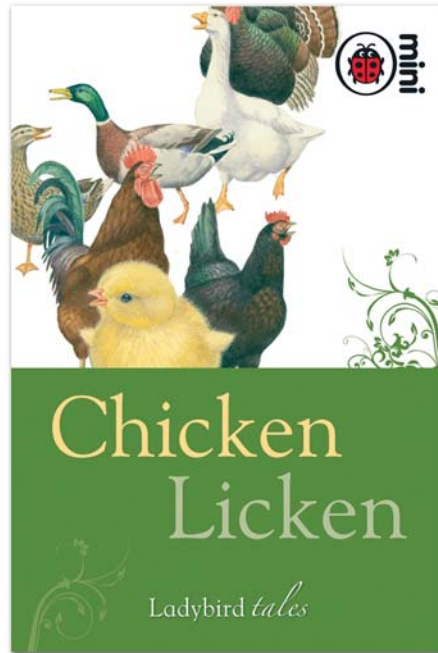
## Spotlight on books for pupils aged 5–7

### Ladybird Tales

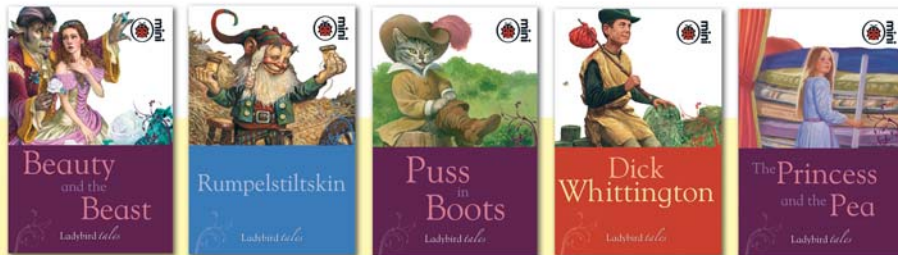

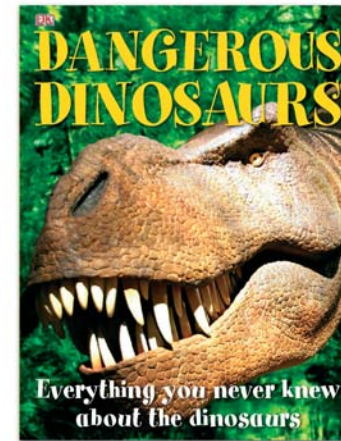


Each one of these classic tales can be sent to your school for **only 10 tokens**. So the only problem is which one to choose first!
