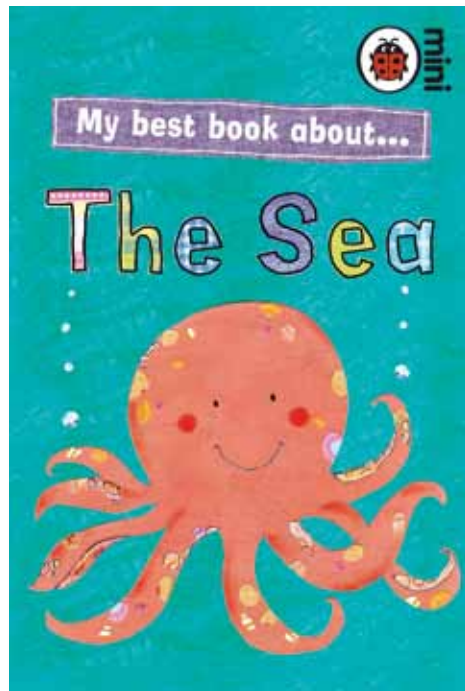
My best book about *The Sea*.
