These are a fun way for your pupils to learn about a range of different subjects, from food chains to Ancient Egypt, the water cycle to how libraries work.

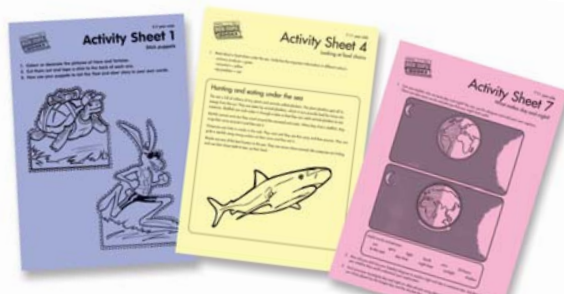
Topic taster 4: Looking at food chains
