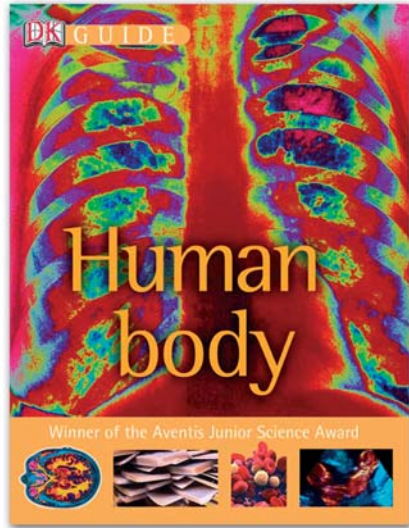

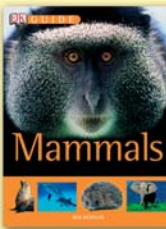
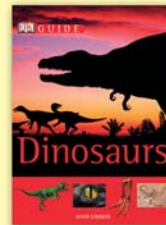


Marvel at the wonders of the human body, from the tiniest cells to the incredible power of the brain.

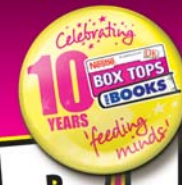

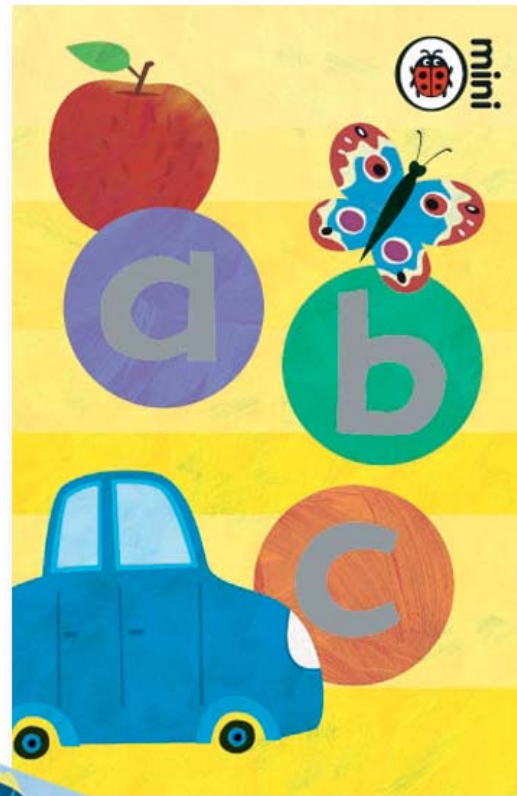
## Spotlight on books for 3-5 year-olds

### New teaching resources

**Henry VII**  
Read the information about Henry VII below. Click on the text to highlight the important dates and events.

Henry was born on 28 January 1457 at Pembroke Castle in Wales. Henry came to power in 1485 after the Battle of Bosworth. Henry was a clever man who managed England's finances carefully, although his strict control made him unpopular with many nobles.

In 1486, Henry married Elizabeth of York and ended the conflict between the House of York and the House of Lancaster.

Henry and his wife were both supporters of Geoffrey Chaucer's 'Canterbury Tales'. Elizabeth died in 1502 and when Henry died in 1509, he was buried beside his wife in Westminster Abbey.
