Henry VII



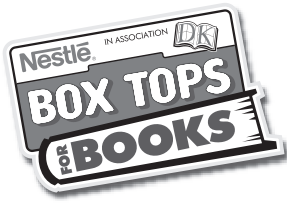
I am not from the Tudor family but married into it. I am buried in Westminster Abbey. Who am I?
